The 1877 plan shows a much smaller building on the site.				
Site Type:	The 1895 and 1910 MMBW plans show the hotel to be rectangular in shape with an extension				
Description	The hotel has archaeological potential both in underground deposits and in the use of archaeology to establish the sequence of building construction.
