History:	The 1855 plans shows the Michael Lynch purchased four lots in the southern end of Section II (Lots 1,2,3 & 10). Lynch was well known to have had a punt crossing the Maribyrnong at this point. The 1855 plan shows a building on lot 1 fronting Maribyrnong Street. There is also a building in Maribyrnong Street itself presumably also relating to the Punt. The building is shown on the 1864 Cox plan. Two buildings are shown on the 1877 plan. The 1895 MMBW plan shows the Ship Inn on the corner and a warehouse (probably the current building on the site of the 1855 building
