<b>History:</b>	<p>The 1854 plan and the 1857-58 sub-division plan show a collection of farm buildings on the north western corner of Portion 4. From the plans this seems to be some form of cultivation and buildings possibly a tenant farm. Later this general area was the site of Emerson's farm (Ford and Lewis 1989:21).</p> <p>The site of these buildings are shown on the 1854 map and on a plan dated to 1857-58 in Ford and Lewis (1989:10).</p>

<b>Description</b>	<p>The plotting of the various plans suggests that some buildings were under Broomfield Street and that there was a building located at the rear of 44-46 Broomfield Street and 127-129 Raleigh Road. It was not possible to inspect these areas from the road.</p>
