Statement of Cultural Significance:

Batman Park commemorates the landing of John Batman and his party in 1835 and it was set aside as a reserve probably in the 1930s. It extends along the foreshore at Indented Head bounded by the Esplanade and it contains the Batman Memorial and the Ozone Monument. The Park is now developed as a camping ground with ablution amenities and boating sheds.

Batman Park has aesthetic, historic and social value to the Indented Head community and to holiday visitors.

Batman Park has high visual qualities with views along the shore line and across the Bay. It is associated with Batman's early exploration of the Bellarine Peninsula and the annual summer holiday influx of visitors.

It is of LOCAL cultural significance.
