





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HISTORY: This house was built for manager, Albert Taylor, in 1926.

VISUAL DESCRIPTION: A simple double-fronted timber Californian Bungalow with a gambrel roof facing. The left bay projects as a gable. Upper gables have shingles. The chimney has a plate-top with clinker-brick decoration. Upper sashes are leadlight.

**SIGNIFICANCE:** A timber Californian Bungalow built in 1926. It is architecturally significant locally as characteristic of this style and historically significant as physical evidence of life in 1920s Newtown.

**COMPARATIVE ANALYSIS:** Numbers 17A, 19, etc.

**INTACTNESS:** Reasonable, excepting that the porch, fence, carport and all finials appear to be recent additions in a deceptively historicist manner.

**CONDITION:** Very good.
